TO: SPEMS EMS Services Utilizing SPEMS Protocols with Dr. Addington as Medical Director

SUBJECT: REMOVAL OF KING LT-D and LTS-D AIRWAY DEVICES SIZES  $0,\,1,\,2,\,\mathrm{and}\,2.5$  FROM EMS UNITS

Due to an FDA issue, the following devices will be immediately removed from all EMS equipment and from the required equipment list for all EMT-Basic, AEMT, and Paramedic Protocols:

- Pediatric King Airway LT-D or LTS-D Airway size 0
- Pediatric King Airway LT-D or LTS-D Airway size 1
- Pediatric King Airway LT-D or LTS-D Airway size 2
- Pediatric King Airway LT-D or LTS-D Airway size 2.5

At this time, this variance does NOT affect the adult sized King Airway Devices. All personnel may continue to utilize the King Airway sizes 3, 4, and 5 as indicated by the SPEMS Protocols.

All personnel should maintain airway control utilizing BLS procedures/adjuncts and intubation as required.

An additional variance will be forthcoming with an alternative device and further guidance.
